As a school, we are very aware of neurodiversity. April is Autism Awareness Month and we are very keen to highlight the strengths and challenges associated with autism among the school community. Awareness is more important than ever this year as we have opened our first autism class. As the oft-quoted saying about autistic people goes, "We are freshwater fish in saltwater. Put us in fresh water and we function just fine. Put us in saltwater and we struggle to survive." Nicole's autism class has truly been that freshwater environment for some of our students and has made a real difference to them and their families. We'd like to take this opportunity to thank Múinteoir Nicole and our Cúntóirí Ranga, Ger, Jonna and Ber for their hard work and dedication to the class and the children.

It is also worth noting that we have other students in the mainstream classes of the school who are autistic or who are awaiting assessment for autism for whom the class is not necessary but who need extra understanding, accommodations, time and support to reach their potential.

Some of you may have seen the excellent series, Inside Our Autistic Minds, with the autistic presenter, Chris Packham on BBC recently. If you missed it, snippets of the show can be seen on YouTube. Finally, we think that this award-winning poem, written by 12-year-old Ava Gallagher is well worth a read. As the saying goes, once you've met one autistic person, you've met one autistic person as each autistic person experiences the world differently. However, this poem does give an insight into what life can be like for people on the spectrum. We plan to share it with our students.
