

A Chara,

I hope this letter finds you well. My name is Aoibhinn Dunne, I am the Fostering Recruitment Officer for the Fostering Resource Unit – Cork area.

Tusla is Ireland's statutory provider of fostering services to children and young people. Tusla Fostering Teams across the country recruit, assess, train and support foster carers. Tusla recruits general Foster Carers who are not related to the children they foster, and relative carers who care for a child of an extended family member or someone that they know. Cork is the largest Fostering Department in the country with over 450 foster families who provide support to many children.

At present, Tusla is experiencing a serious shortage of Foster Carers countrywide. We are redoubling our efforts in 2024 to recruit additional foster carers across all age groups in Cork city and county and make every effort to ensure that children who come into care can be cared for in their local area where possible.

We are calling on all early years providers, Primary Schools and Secondary Schools in Cork City and County to help ensure that children and young people who require alternative care can be placed together with their siblings and can remain connected to their local schools and communities. To this end, I am writing to request a recruitment campaign within the school through the use of bulk texting systems, WhatsApp groups or school-based apps such as Aladdin etc. This would simply be a message to all parents and staff alerting them to the shortage of foster carers in their area, inviting them to attend an online fostering information evening and directing them to the www.fostering.ie website for additional information. I would welcome a discussion with you on this matter and I am open to hosting in-person information sessions in your area and for your school community.

I would be grateful if you would consider putting this letter and/or enclosed leaflet on the staff notice board.
