Má tá na comharthaí seo ag do pháiste, le bhur dtoil ná seol ar scoil iad. Le cúnamh Dé cabhróidh an nós seo le stopadh leathadh an ghalair agus le cosaint a thabhairt dos na páistí agus dá múinteoirí. Tá ganntanas ionadaithe ar son múinteoirí breoite ann faoi láthair. There continues to be a large number of children with tummy bugs and stomach infections at the moment. If your child is experiencing these symptoms, please do not send them to school. This will hopefully help to stop the spread of bugs and protect the children and their teachers. As you may be aware, there is a substitute teacher crisis at present and it is extremely difficult to access substitute teachers for sick staff. Please note the HSE recommends that children stay at home 48 hours from their last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting.

Allianz, our insurers, have advised us to reiterate that supervised supervision on school grounds does not commence until 8:40a.m. Children from 5th+6th classes only are permitted on the school grounds and the Astro at 8:30 a.m. for training purposes as they are being supervised by a teacher. Parents and bus drivers are not permitted to allow children to be on school grounds unsupervised until 8:40 a.m. as they are not covered by insurance.
